Entry Conditions

Entry to the Midlands Championships is via a club coordinator who is responsible for communicating all information to and from the swimmers. Entry is subject to the conditions below, the general meet conditions and the supplementary Para-Swimming conditions as published on the website: www.midlandchampionships.org.uk

COACH PASSES:

East Midlands: purchase on-line by accessing the National accreditation system. In the event of a problem contact fiona.conway@swimming.org

West Midlands: Annual passes are valid for this competition; additional weekend passes may be purchased on-line at www.wmswimchamps.org.uk

1. On-line entry will be available from the 1st September. Club co-ordinators are required to request the on-line entry link by emailing meets@midlandchampionships.org.uk

By requesting the link you are agreeing to your email being used for all communication regarding this meet

2. The club coordinator shall be responsible for:
 - a. Checking and validating the swimmers entries and fees
 - b. Submitting entries on-line and making payment via PayPal
 - c. Checking the submitted entry list on the website. Known errors must be reported to the meet administrator before the closing date.
3. Entry procedures:
 - a. Swimmer details and entry times must appear in the online system which reads data from the SE Membership and British Rankings databases. The entry system automatically selects the best time which may be a converted time.
 - b. Entry times must be achieved in a licensed level 1-3 meets between the 1st January 2018 and the closing date.
 - c. Split times, either intermediate distance or first leg of a relay, are not acceptable for entry.
 - d. Para-Swimmers may enter any event subject to meeting the able-bodied qualifying standards or selected events which are subject to the multi-classification standards published in the supplementary conditions.

Entry Conditions

- e. Entry fees:
 - £8.00** per event
 - £1.00** individual relay swimmers who are **NOT** entering an individual event
 - £10** per relay team.
 - f. **Entries close Midnight - Thursday 18th October.**
 - g. After the closing date refund of entry fees will only be given on medical grounds and evidence may be requested
4. A swimmer failing to comply with any of the foregoing conditions shall not be allowed to compete in the championship.
 5. The full meet time line and withdrawal procedures will be published as soon as possible after the close of entries.
 6. Any question arising, for which these conditions do not provide shall be determined by the Promoter.
